The Department of Business Administration in the College of Business at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (UIUC) is seeking a post-doctoral fellow starting fall 2018. Our department is a vibrant and diverse interdisciplinary community consisting of Information Systems, International Business, Organizational Behavior, Marketing, Strategy & Entrepreneurship, Process Management, and Supply Chain Management. In addition, UIUC is known for its excellence in information technology (IT) related research across the campus. This fellowship will be situated in the information systems area but will have access to the broader scholarly community of the department, college, and university.

The Illinois IS Postdoctoral Fellowship is a two-year or a three-year position. Applicants must have completed a doctorate in IS, management or a related discipline (other business areas, data science, computer science, economics, industrial engineering, for examples) prior to beginning the fellowship, and should be research focused. Fellows are also invited to audit courses and are encouraged to participate in the department's scholarly seminars and other intellectual activities.

Illinois Fellows will have the opportunity to collaborate with other fellows, work with faculty in the IS group and other areas throughout the university, as well as pursue their own research. All fellows will have a research budget that may be further augmented through university grants. The salary is competitive with other post-doc programs. In exchange, fellows will be expected to teach two classes per year. Teaching assignments are flexible and negotiable.
