Additional nominations may be submitted to the Home Office for any position on the slate by January 10, accompanied by a petition signed by at least 5% of the voting-eligible membership requesting such addition. At this time, that number is 55. More information on requesting an addition to the slate can be requested from the Home Office.

A reminder that only active dues-paying members are entitled to vote. The cut-off date for active membership will be Friday, January 21, 2022. Members joining after this date will not be eligible for voting in this election. The election will open on January 26, 2021 and run for twenty (20) days.
