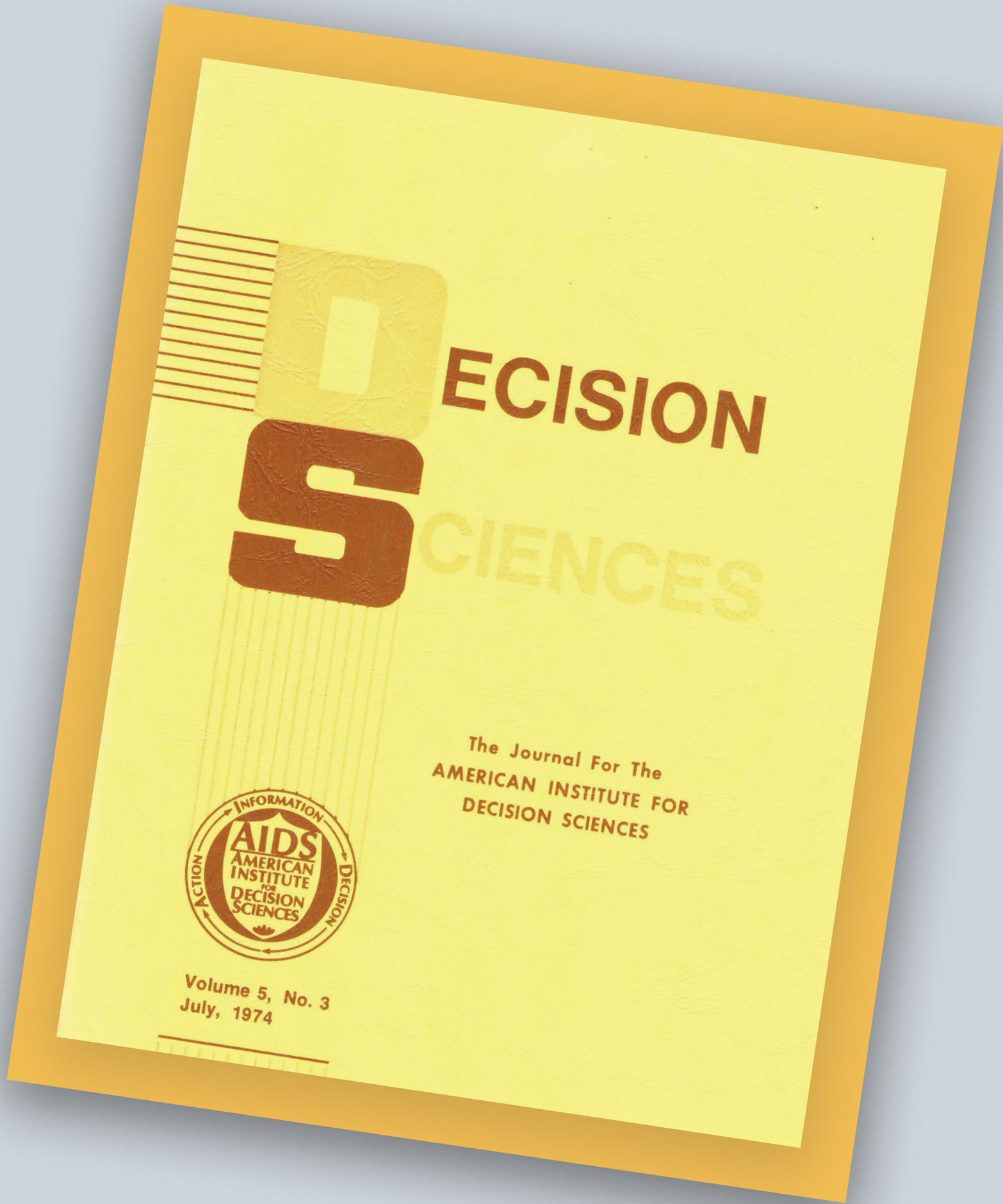

Objective for the Year: Reorganization

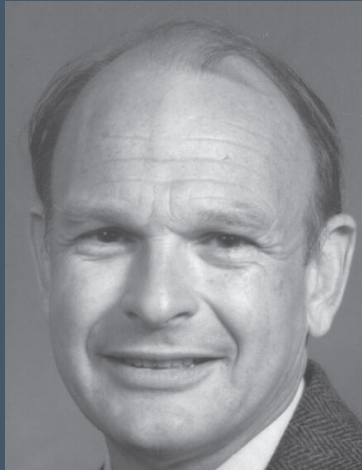
President Groff states: Growth of orgnization dictates the need to reorganize; Board should focus on policy-making; need for coordination and support of regions.
